1. **Disco** - the date has been set for July 12th. All proceeds will go towards Urafiki.
2. **Litter picks** - Willow and Ash are going to do a litter pick on the field this Friday afternoon. Other classes could take it in turns to do one half termly after that.
3. **E-team link** - Mrs Legg has suggested that members of the e-team are represented at School Council meetings. LV and RP are members of both and will be the link between the two committees. Current e-team actions include completing the planting for pollinators, caring for the wormery and reminding staff and children about saving electricity by using the 'owl eyes' displays.
4. **Science** - Mrs Hunt is now the co-ordinator for science and asked councillors if they could share their experience of science lessons in school. All children reported that they enjoyed practical science lessons, with plants and habitats being the most popular topics across school. The children preferred practical lessons with 'lots of doing' to 'listening to the teacher talk.' Science was seen as a 'good' subject as it covered a wide range of areas, including electricity, evolution, human bodies, materials, sound, plants and habitats. KS2 classes have science lessons every week. Beech class reported opportunities were given to carry out investigations, whilst Oak children felt they had more lessons based on using technology to research topics. Oak children also reported their enjoyment in raising their own questions to investigate in recent work with Miss Berry.
